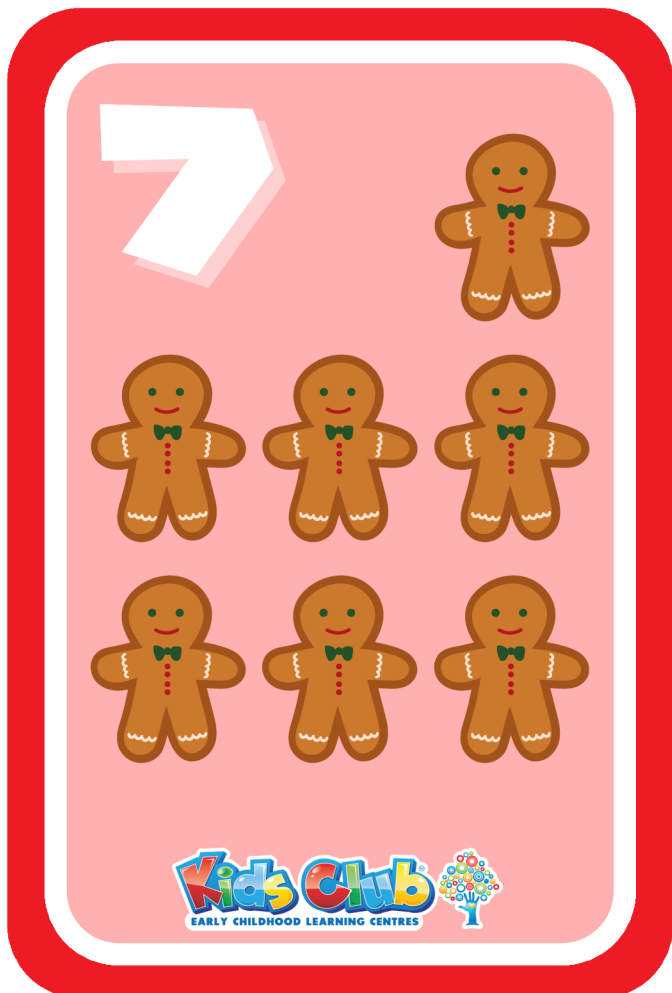
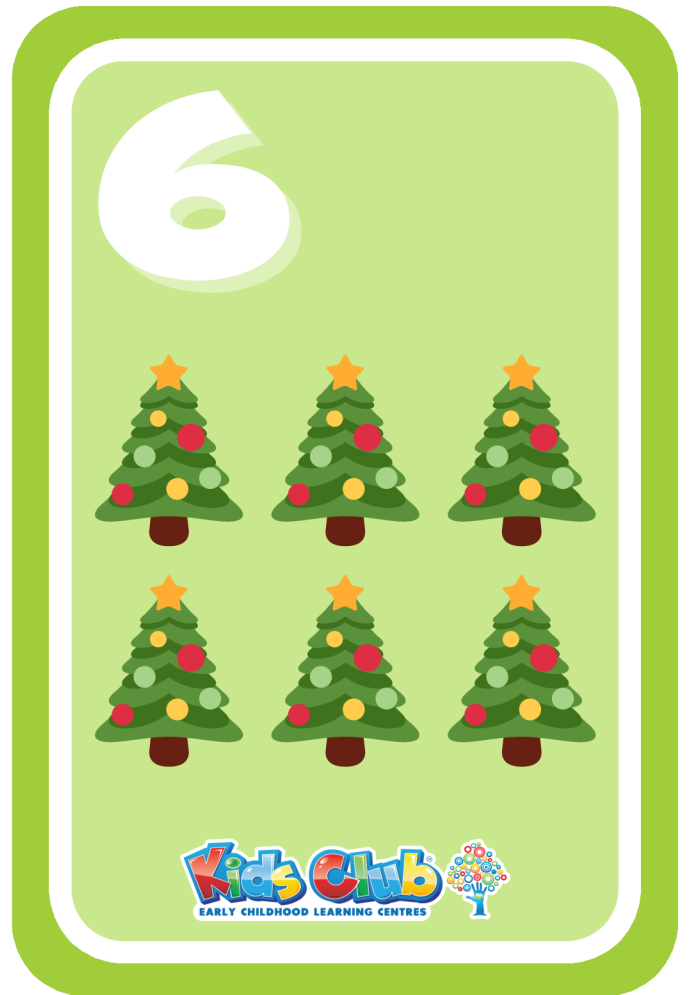
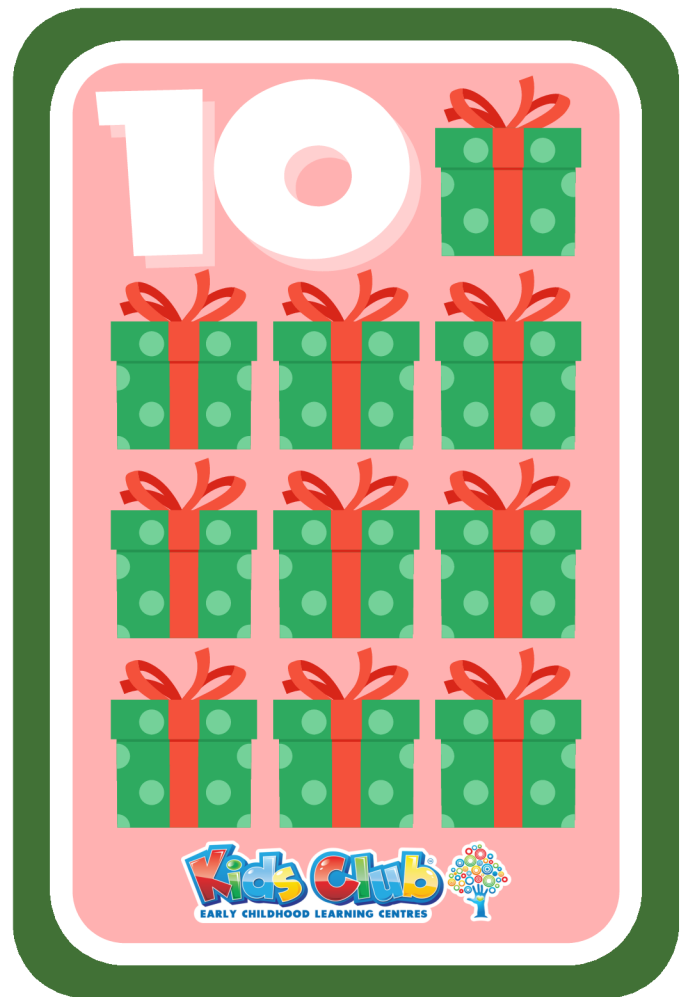








GAME IDEAS:

Number Hunt & Match

- Print out 2 sets of cards
- Spread one set face up on the table
- Hold up cards from the second set one at a time
- Ask children to find the matching number on the table
- Make it active by spreading cards around the room and having kids "hunt" for the matching number
- Learning outcome: Number recognition and matching.

What Comes Next?

- Print out 2 sets of cards
- Lay out 3-4 cards in sequence (e.g., 1,2,3)
- Mix the remaining cards face down
- Children pick a card and try to continue the sequence
- If they get it wrong, the card goes back
- Learning outcome: Number sequence understanding.

Memory Plus

- Print out 2 sets of cards
- Place all cards face down
- Children turn over two cards
- If they match, they must count out that number using fingers or objects to keep the cards
- If they count correctly, they keep the pair
- If they don't match, turn them back over
- Learning outcome: Memory skills, number recognition, and counting practice.
